

The Philips mixer with bar blender can confidently handle a large variety of ingredients. With the powerful 5 speeds and turbo, the stainless steel wire beaters/strip beaters and kneading hooks make light work of the toughest dough.

HR1574 is equipped with the innovative FlexiMix system, which allows the beaters and dough hooks to move up and down when they touch the bowl. The two wire beaters/ strip beaters (or kneading hooks) move independently of each other, which allows them to adjust to the shape of every bowl. As a result, it is much easier to reach every part of the bowl and to mix all ingredients thoroughly. The FlexiMix system makes the mixer easier to handle and gives you better control over the mixing process.

### 1 Turbo knob

- (For the wire beaters/strip beaters/ kneading hooks only) Press and hold to increase the speed for a heavy job
- (For the bar blender only) Press and hold to switch on the bar blender

### 2 Speed control

- **0**: Switch off the wire beaters/strip beaters/kneading hooks
- 1 2 3 4 5: Switch on the wire beaters/ strip beaters/ kneading hooks and select a proper speed

- Press to release the inserted wire beaters/strip beaters/kneading hooks

# 4 Use the appliance


### Before the first use

Before you use the appliance for the first time, thoroughly clean the parts that come into contact with food (see 'Cleaning' on page 12).

- 1 Clean the motor unit with a moist cloth.
- 2 Clean the beaters, kneading hooks, bar blender, and beaker in warm water with some washing-up liquid or in a dishwasher.

# Wire beaters/strip beaters/kneading hooks

Insert the wire/strip beaters or kneading hooks into the main unit until you hear a click.



- 2 Insert the plug in the power outlet.
- **3** Put the ingredients in a bowl.
- 4 Lower the inserted the wire/strip beaters or kneading hooks into the ingredients.

Select a proper speed, from 1 to 5, to switch on the wire/strip beaters or kneading hooks. To avoid splashing, start mixing at a low speed, and then switch to a higher speed.



For a heavy job, press and hod while processing.



 (For HR1574) If you want to use the FlexiMix function, set the FlexiMix button to W.



**6** After use, turn the speed selector to **0**, and then unplug the appliance.

7 Press **≜** to release the wire/strip beaters or kneading hooks.




**₩** Tip

• If the door for the wire beaters, strip beaters, or kneading hooks is blocked, close the bar blender door to open it.

### Bar blender

1 Make sure that the speed selector is turned to **0**.



2 Open the door for the bar blender.



- 3 Insert the bar blender into the back of the main unit, and then turn it clockwise until the indication on the bar blender and the one on the main unit align.
  - → When the bar blender is installed properly, you can hear a didk.



- 4 Insert the plug in the power outlet.
- Put the ingredients in the storage beaker, and then lower the bar blender into the ingredients.
- Press and hold to switch on the bar blender.



- After use, turn the speed selector to **0**, and then unplug the appliance.
- Turn the bar blender anticlockwise to release it.
- Close the bar blender door.

### Spice Bread

Ingredients

- 250 g flour
- 150 g rye flour
- 250 g honey (cold)
- 150 g sugar
- 11 g yeast
- 4 g cinnamon
- 50 ml milk
- 1 egg
- 1 Put the ingredients in a bowl.
- 2 Turn the speed selector to 1.
- 3 Knead the dough with the wire beaters/strip beaters for 1 minute.
- 4 Put the bowl with the dough in warm place for 20 minutes.
- Press and hold to mix the ingredients for 10 seconds.
- 6 Bake the spice bread in a baking tin at 180°C for approximately 1 hour.



Tip

• This recipe is extremely heavy for your mixer. Let your mixer cool down to room temperature.

### Pizza

Ingredients

- 500 g flour
- 3 g dried yeast
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon sea salt
- 1 Put all the dry ingredients in the bowl.
- Turn the speed selector to **5**, and mix the ingredients for about 5 minutes.
- **3** Pour in water and oil slowly.
- 4 Knead until a well mixed ball is formed.
- Leave the dough to rise at room temperature under a clean cloth for half an hour.
- 6 Knead the dough well and leave to rise for another half an hour.
- 7 Preheat the oven to 230-250°C.
- Roll out the dough to the desired size. Cover with tomato sauce and decorate with ingredients, like cheese, salami, anchovies, or grilled vegetables.
- 9 Bake the pizza for 10-15 minutes until it golden brown.

# 5 Cleaning

### Caution

- Before you clean the appliance or release any accessory, unplug it.
- 1 Clean the motor unit with a moist cloth.
- 2 Clean the beaters, kneading hooks, blender bar, and beaker in warm water with some washing-up liquid or in a dishwasher.



### 6 Storage


1 Wind the power cord round the heel of the appliance.



Put the beaters, kneading hooks, and blender bar in the storage beaker.



**3** (For HR1574) Cover the storage beaker.



4 Store the appliance in a dry place away from direct sunlight or other sources of heat
